We still have Maundy Thursday and Good Friday observances before we will gather to celebrate Easter, The Resurrection of our Lord. To get to Easter, we must go through the cross. - 2. Then we will explore "How God works to make us His own."
- 3. We will also look at what it means to "Die to self and be raised in Christ.
- 4. Another session will help discern the age-old question, "What is God's purpose for my life?"
- 5. And finally, we will look at the pattern of our lives as we follow Jesus and learn from Him.


Our resources will be the Holy Scriptures, Luther's Small Catechism, and of course your own insights and discoveries.

It is my vision that we will become a congregation of Disciples that will deepen their relationship with Jesus who won for you your salvation, to also deepen our relationship with one another as a community of Christ who are on the same journey of faith.
